

### Your options on leaving don't change

Under the new law, you can still access your vested pot and savings pot (as long as you haven't already made a withdrawal in the tax year) if you leave your employer. You can choose to take this money in cash if you resign, dismissed, or retrenched. The two-pot system does not affect your options on leaving. It's only your retirement pot that you won't be able to access until you retire.

The table below briefly explains which "pots" of money you can access when you leave your employer.

| "Your pots"  | Your option when leaving  |
|--|---|
|  <p><b>Vested pot</b> - Your vested pot contains the money you saved up until 31 August 2024 and future growth.</p> | Withdraw cash or preserve.  |
|  <p><b>Savings pot</b> - contains <b>one-third</b> of your ongoing contributions from 1 September 2024.</p>        | Withdraw cash or preserve:<br>If a withdrawal has not already been made in the tax year or if the amount is less than R2 000. |
|  <p><b>Retirement pot</b> - contains <b>two-thirds</b> of your ongoing contributions from 1 September 2024</p>    | Only accessible at retirement as monthly pension.   |
